READ 1 John 2:3-11

Love and Hatred for Fellow Believers

³ We know that we have come to know him if we keep his commands. ⁴ Whoever says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. ⁵ But if anyone obeys his word, love for God^[a] is truly made complete in them. This is how we know we are in him: ⁶ Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did.

⁷ Dear friends, I am not writing you a new command but an old one, which you have had since the beginning. This old command is the message you have heard. ⁸ Yet I am writing you a new command; its truth is seen in him and in you, because the darkness is passing and the true light is already shining.

⁹ Anyone who claims to be in the light but hates a brother or sister^[b] is still in the darkness. ¹⁰ Anyone who loves their brother and sister^[c] lives in the light, and there is nothing in them to make them stumble. ¹¹ But anyone who hates a brother or sister is in the darkness and walks around in the darkness. They do not know where they are going, because the darkness has blinded them.

- I. How do we know if WE are saved
 - a. Not They they is between them and God and you aren't the judge HE is.
 - i. Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling
 - Why fear and trembling?

 we just don't have the wisdom to judge it even in ourselves but hear is a test/..
 - b. We obey his commands.
 - i. Not most, not more than the person next to you. all of them.
 - ii. Jesus in Jn 14:15 "If you love me keep my commandments."
 - iii. In my house there are rules not a lot but some.
 - 1. Biggest rule is do what I say.
 - iv. Lack of obedience to the leader demonstrates rebellion
 - If Jesus is the the Lord of our life and this is the word of God, we must do what it says. Even if it causes discomfort.

- v. If we obey, Gods love is made complete
 - 2 greatest commandments Dt 6:5, Lev 19:18.
 - 2. ⁸Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law. ⁹The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery," "You shall not murder," "You shall not steal," "You shall not covet,"^[a] and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."^{[b] 10} Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law
- vi. This is how we know we are in in him – if we love – not they – we as individuals
- vii. Walk as jesus did Phil 2.
