 - b. found himself hungry and was motivated to get a job
4. Safety - financial and health - gone
5. Love and belonging - this is not where I am supposed to be.

Oldest Son

1. Esteem threatened - he blew it while i did everything right
2. Love - twinge of jealousy

Father fills all

1. Physiological - immediately fed, clothed
2. Safety - finances - a ring is put on his finger
3. Esteem the father runs
4. love/belonging - throws his arm around him and throws a big party
5. Self actualization
 - a. i wanna be all that I can be

- b. left to his own devices he found he wasn't that much
- c. with the Father he is all he can be.
